

Rules and legal conditions of Elisava Scholarships

Valid promotion to study an Elisava master's degree, starting on September 2026 or February 2027*.

*Except for the masters in the area of communication (Master in Audiovisual Creation and Direction, Master in Art Direction, Master in Creative Direction and Communication, Master in Art Direction and New Narratives) that organize the Fahrenheit Scholarships during the same dates. 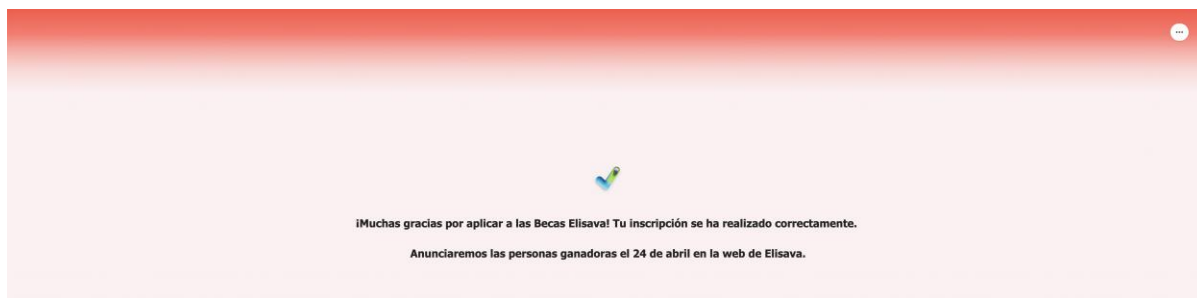
How to apply?

1. For all masters (except the Master in Design and Communication) You must fill in the application form with your personal information and select the master you want to study. In the same form, you must upload the following materials:

- + Video – presentation (maximum 30 seconds, mp4 or mov format) in the language of the master's degree you want to study.
- + Portfolio (maximum 2 GB)

Remember that to complete your registration, you must return to the form once you have uploaded your files and click on the 'submit' button.

This message at the bottom of the form confirms that your registration was successful. **You will not receive a confirmation email.**



+ You can only apply for one master's degree in one of the two campuses. If you apply for more than one master or more than one campus, your application will be invalidated.

+ In order to participate and be eligible for the scholarship, you must send the material requested in the rules, but in no case it is necessary to make or pay the pre-registration for the master's degree beforehand.

+ A jury from Elisava will evaluate the creativity and quality of the material submitted. The criteria on which the jury will be based are creativity and innovation, as well as the motivation of the students to study the master's degree at our university.

- + Once the scholarship winner has been selected, Elisava will contact them by email to confirm their decision to enrol in the selected master's degree programme. The winner will have **15 days to accept or decline** the scholarship. Subsequently, payment of 50% of the programme not covered by the scholarship will be made as follows: **25% of the amount within 15 days** of acceptance of the scholarship and the remaining **25% before 1 June**.
- + The call for scholarships closes on the last day of the established period at 00:00 (Spanish time). We recommend that you do not wait until the last minute to send your application, as if there is an interruption in the connection and we receive it after the deadline, it will be invalidated.
- + The scholarship application period closes at midnight (Spanish time) on the last day of the period. The application process takes a few minutes, so we advise you not to leave it until the last minute as it may be interrupted and your application may be cancelled.
- + The winners of the scholarships will be notified via email, the website (elisava.net) and the school's social networks ([@elisava.school](https://twitter.com/elisava.school)). Candidates who do not result selected, will not be notified via email.
- + In the event that the Master's programme cannot be completed, the scholarship winner may apply for another Master's programme or keep their scholarship for the following year.
- + In the event that the winner decides not to attend the master's degree course, the jury may assign the scholarship to another finalist candidate. If the winner decides not to take the course in the 2026-2027 call, the scholarship will be forfeited. In no case will the scholarship amount be paid to the student.
- + The scholarship may be declared void if the jury determines that the candidates do not meet the established requirements.
- + The scholarship holder must actively participate in all special and multidisciplinary projects proposed by the School: events, lectures, extracurricular projects and workshops.
- + Failure to comply with any of the obligations described above will result in the loss of the scholarship.

Legal note: The data voluntarily provided by participants in the attached form will be collected in a database called BDGAEESD, owned by Elisava, School of Design and Engineering of Barcelona. We will only use the data to attend the present request and to inform about our activities and courses by ordinary or electronic mail. In any case, and at any time, candidates may consult, access, rectify, cancel or oppose to the processing of their data by contacting our offices located in La Rambla 30-32, Barcelona (AA/TT: Administration Department) or by e-mail to administracio@elisava.net.
